Suggested Antibiotic Prophylaxis Regimens

For patients not allergic to penicillin or cephalosporins

- Cephalexin or amoxicillin, 2 grams orally 1 hour prior to dental procedure.
- Patients unable to take oral medications: cefazolin 1 gram or ampicillin 2 grams IM/IV 1 hour prior to the procedure.
- No second doses are recommended for any of these dosing regimens.

Suggested Antibiotic Prophylaxis Regimens

For patients allergic to penicillin or cephalosporins

- **Clindamycin 600 mg orally 1 hour prior to the dental procedure.**
- **Patients unable to take oral medications: clindamycin 600 mg IM/IV 1 hour prior to the procedure.**
- **No second doses are recommended for any of these dosing regimens.**

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
